Students will receive two grades in each class, one for academics and one for employability.

Academic grades are exclusively based on assessments, quizzes and tests. It will be important for students to work hard and to be dedicated. We have a math website that students can access for helpful "how-to" videos, games and many other online resources to help with the concepts taught in class.

Employability grades reflect student's behavior and choices. Every student begins each marking period with an 100%, A. Points are kept when students complete homework on time, make good choices in class, and come to class prepared and on time. Five points are lost for each infraction. For example, when work is not completed on time, students lose five points employability that cannot be made up. Work completion helps students maintain a good employability grade, and helps to develop skills and concepts resulting in better comprehension and scores on assessments (tests and quizzes).
