## EMPLOYABILITY GRADE

All students begin with a $100 \%$ grade.

## HOW POINTS ARE DEDUCTED

Five points are deducted for every instance a student displays a behavior that would be considered unemployable according to the tardy and SRC categories, is not prepared for class or doesn't follow directions. Once a student has lost points, he/she is unable to earn any points back for that marking period.

With each new marking period, students are given a $100 \%$ employability grade to start. This allows them the opportunity to evaluate their previous habits, set goals and make any necessary improvements.

Students help maintain a safe environment for learning by demonstrating respect for themselves, the teacher, and their peers. Students are cooperative.
