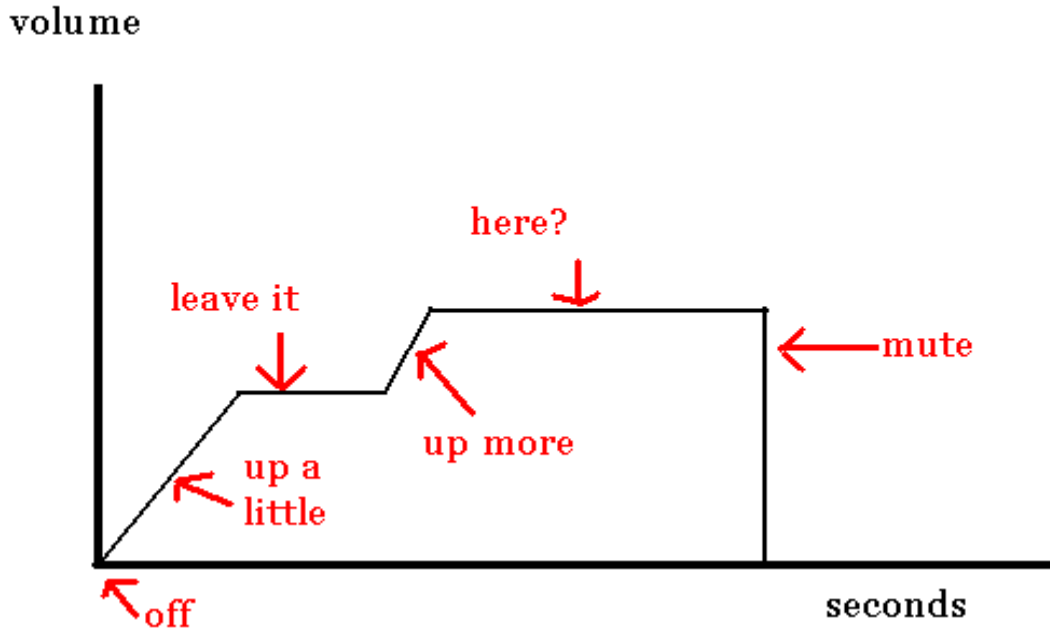

Here is an example of a graph that tells a story about listening to the radio:

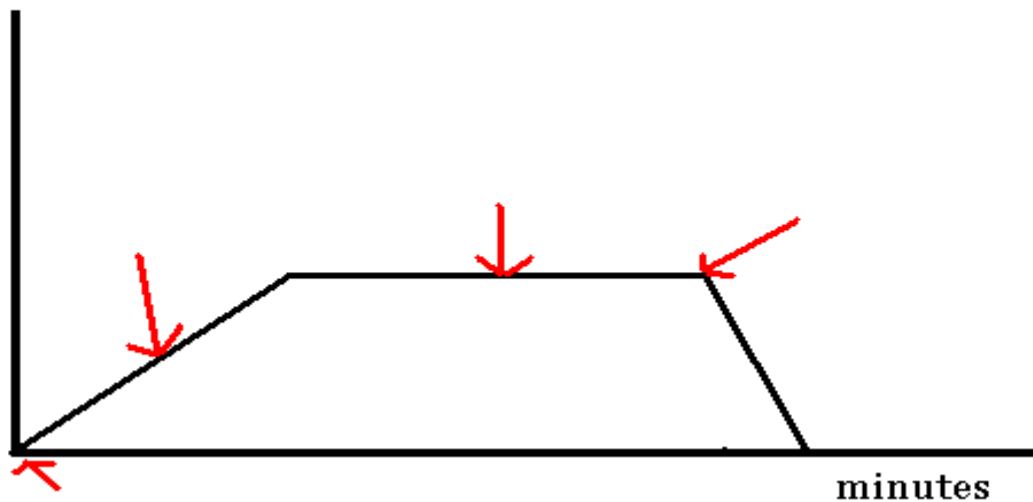
Listening to the radio



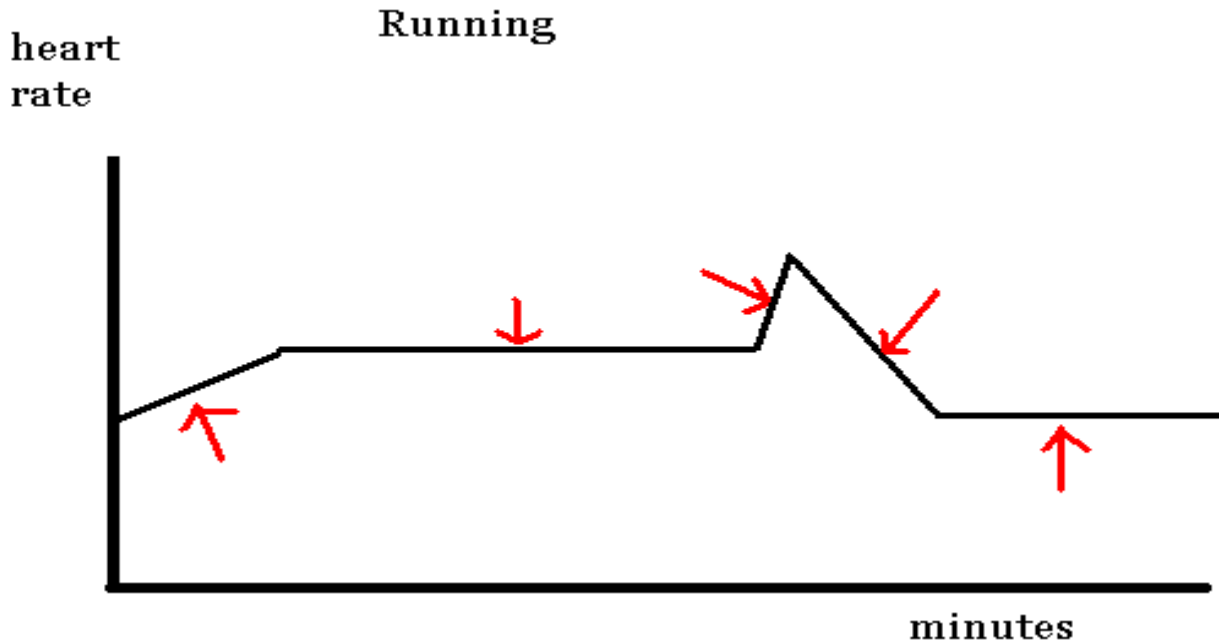
#1) No matter what story the graph is telling, what does a flat horizontal line represent?
